



Pilot Overview

Objective

The Commander pilot program enables federal agencies to evaluate the platform within their own SharePoint environment, focusing on **measurable improvements in governance, efficiency, and operational visibility**.

Scope & Approach

The pilot is conducted over **30–60 days** within a controlled subset of site collections. SummitPoint works with agency stakeholders to identify priority use cases aligned to mission and operational challenges.

Key Evaluation Areas

- Permissions auditing and access control validation
- Workflow visibility and modernization opportunities
- Storage analysis and content lifecycle management
- Bulk administrative operations across lists and sites
- Configuration standardization and governance enforcement

Execution

SummitPoint provides:

- Platform deployment and configuration support
- Role-based onboarding and training
- Guided validation of high-priority use cases
- Ongoing technical support throughout the pilot

Outcomes & Deliverables

At completion, agencies receive:

- Quantified improvements in administrative efficiency
- Identified security and compliance gaps
- Recommendations for governance standardization
- Roadmap for broader enterprise deployment
